Job Summary:

Under the general supervision of the Facilities Director and Maintenance Supervisor, the primary function of this position is to perform all housekeeping and cleaning duties within the Penobscot County Buildings complex at 97 Hammond Street, Bangor, Maine.

Essential Duties/Responsibilities:

- Vacuum, sweep, wash/mop and shampoo floors;
- Emptying and cleaning wastebaskets;
- Hygienic cleaning, stocking paper goods and soap
- Cleaning Restrooms and shower areas;
- Stripping and waxing floors;
- Washing door glass, interior windows, and glass walls;
- Performs the proper handling of cleaning chemicals with adherence to SDS guidelines and warnings;

- Dusting and waxing furniture, woodwork, handrails, windowsills, blinds;
- Interacts with the public and co-workers in a positive and professional manner.

Knowledge/Skills/Experience required:

High School diploma or equivalent required, 5 years related experience is required.

Scheduled Hours:

The position is a 40 hour work week Monday through Friday, 3 pm - 11pm.

Work Environment and Physical Demands:
